3. I would like to propose that if a club member receives a place in the London Marathon from the club ballot that they should then not receive a place via the club ballot for the following 3 years.

In addition to this getting a place via the official London ballot is almost impossible. To make sure the club shares the experience to as many of our club runners as possible this is why I propose the 3 year period.

I don't think anyone would keep taking the ballot places but this just makes it formal and ensure as many of our club members get the chance as possible, especially as we are growing so quickly.

5. An away running top in Purple, branded PRR with a Scottish Flag on the arm.

The top should be made of moisture wicking material and be available in both male and female fit. The Scottish flag should be added due to this being an

away top, on a few occasions I have been asked if I have come all the way from Australia.

The top should not be used at any PRR events, both organised by or as part of the Championship, Summer Series, Hill Series or Cross Country. If the event is the Championship, Summer Series or Hill Series and our Green PRR top is not worn then you will not be included as having run that race for points in the Championship, Summer Series or Hill Series.

I realise that there would be a cost for these tops and holding stock can be a problem so the tops should be arranged on an order as required by club members basis. I am aware there is good support for an away top, so I would like this considered as part of the AGM.
