

HEAVEN AND HELL INFORMATION

VENUE Scone Airport: located A94 Perth to Coupar Angus Road.

REGISTRATION: At the main hall – “The Hangar” follow the signs to race registration on arrival at the airport entrance. There will be a race briefing in the registration hall at approximately 10:30am. Please note that the minimum age for this event is 18 years.

PARKING: Ample parking available at the main hall

START/FINISH LINE:

Start Line - a few minutes walk from the registration hall.

Finish Line - approximately ½ a mile from the registration hall.

We will be transporting items of clothing (jackets, fleeces, hats etc) from the start line to the finish line. However we cannot transport large items such as kit bags to the finish line. Unfortunately there is no shelter at the finish line, if the weather is unfavourable, please ensure suitable clothing has been transported. The last 3 miles of the race can be exposed to the elements if the weather is windy. Please avoid the temptation to discard outer layers of running gear to friends / marshals on the more sheltered parts of the course. Keep clothing with you as it may well be required when reaching the peak of the hill at 10 miles.

POLICE INSTRUCTIONS:

Tayside Traffic Police have issued instructions which we ask runners to adhere to, please comply with their requirements as the future of this event will depend on the cooperation of the participants.

- 1) PLEASE WEAR HI-VIS CLOTHING
- 2) Be aware that the all road traffic has complete right of way, runners must give way to road vehicles in all situations.
- 3) Do not run more than 2 abreast.
- 4) The “T” road junction at the 4 mile point has been categorised as a “medium risk” area. The area will be marshalled and signposted accordingly, please be guided by marshals, cross to the left side of the road with caution, and remain on the left until you are clear of the bend.
- 5) When returning to the registration hall after the event, please use the footpath alongside the A94. Don’t walk or run on the road.

RUNNING NUMBERS: Please pin race numbers on front of clothing, so time-keeping marshals can identify runners approaching the finish line.

WATER STATIONS: These will be at approximately 5, 8 & 10 miles.

CHANGING: There are no showers at the registration hall. The nearest public showers are at Bells Sports Centre in Hay Street, Perth.

PRIZE GIVING: Will take place at the registration hall, approximately 2:15pm.

FIRST AID: First aid vehicles will follow at back of the field, please relay any messages to marshals on route should their services be required.

RACE RESULTS: Will be available from the club website as soon as possible following the event.
